Decals Requirement: YES Location and # of decals: One “H” decal must be placed, no closer than 3” to Honda Racing/HPD decal. One “HONDA” decal must be placed on each side of the engine cover near the top. No exceptions will be made for this rule. Decal availability: Decals are available directly from HPD and are automatically mailed out when you register for the Honda Racing Line program with HPD.
