<b>Registration Requirements:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ To be eligible, competitor must be a registered member of the Honda Racing Line Program.</li> <li>✓ Competitor must be registered prior to the event in which they are claiming awards.</li> </ul>		
<b>Usage Requirements:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To be eligible for this program, competitors must be in the Canadian Touring Car Championship.</li> <li>2. Competitor must use an eligible Honda or Acura vehicle to claim parts credits.</li> <li>3. Competitor must use 2016-up Civic Si car to claim cash awards.</li> <li>4. Location and # of required decals: One 15" Honda Racing/HPD decal must be placed on the nose of the car. Two 24" Honda Racing/HPD decals must be located on either upper rear quarter panel.</li> <li>5. Decal availability: Honda Racing/HPD decals are available directly from HPD and are automatically mailed out when you register for the Honda Racing Line program with HPD.</li> </ol>		
<b>Award Details:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in above class drivers are eligible for the HPD Bucks or Cash awards listed below depending on model raced (competitor may NOT claim both credit and cash awards)</li> <li>✓ Parts Credits may be used for Honda OE parts, Honda Racing/HPD performance parts, or Honda Generators available from HPD. Credits will not count towards shipping or customs charges.</li> <li>✓ All points must be earned in Honda/Acura vehicle to be eligible for Driver Champion bonus</li> <li>✓ Awards will strictly be based on <b>official</b> race results supplied by CTCC. Awards cannot be claimed until CTCC has released official race results. Mylaps.com or similar are not acceptable.</li> <li>✓ If you are eligible for an award through the HPD CTCC Contingency program, you will need to submit the official claim sheet (<a href="http://hpd.honda.com/racing-line/contingency-programs/">http://hpd.honda.com/racing-line/contingency-programs/</a>).</li> </ul>		
<b>Additional Information:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ This optional contingency program is verified by Canadian Touring Car and HPD.</li> <li>✓ Awards are administered by Honda Performance Development.</li> <li>✓ Awards are reduced by 50% for the race/championship with fewer than 10 starters overall</li> <li>✓ Competitor must provide W-9 or W-8 BEN tax forms to HPD with first claim</li> <li>✓ Claims must be made within 30 days of the event</li> <li>✓ Parts Credits EXPIRE within 180 days of claim</li> </ul>
